Dear Parents, Students, and Staff

We were informed **only this morning** that NYC will not be transporting students until September 10. As such, we are forced to begin classes on September 10 rather than September 8. Please note as well on the attached revised calendar that school will now be held on March 15 and June 23, which will now be our tentative last day of school.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience these changes may cause. Please know though that we are doing everything we can to serve you to the best of our abilities.

### **Just to clarify our new calendar:**

Seniors and Juniors who have chosen to be exclusively remote will meet from 8:20 until 12:20 Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, beginning September 10<sup>th</sup>. Seniors and Juniors who are going to be attending in person will begin in person on Monday, September 14. They will continue to attend in person on Mondays and Tuesdays from 8:00 – 12:30. They will attend remotely on every Thursday and Friday. No Students will attend in person on Wednesdays which are designated as days for asynchronous learning where assignments will be issued by teachers through google classroom or other means. Beginning Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup> and each Wednesday going forward all students will attend classes virtually on Wednesdays for the entire period 1 – 9 schedule.

Sophomores and Freshmen who have chosen to be exclusively remote will meet from 8:20 until 12:20 Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays beginning September 10<sup>th</sup>. Freshman and Sophomores who are going to be attending in person will begin in person on Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>. They will continue to attend in person on Thursdays and Fridays from 8:00 – 12:30. They will attend remotely on every Monday and Tuesday. No students will attend in person on

Wednesdays which are designated as days for asynchronous learning until October 7<sup>th</sup> as described above for all students.

Please note that we are moving to a block schedule. Periods 1-4 will be held Mondays and Thursdays and periods 5-9 will be held Tuesdays and Fridays. Each class is one hour long. Our opening day on Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup> will begin with homeroom at 8:20 followed by periods 1 - 4. On student's virtual days, either Monday and Tuesday (for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders) or Thursdays and Fridays (for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders) afternoons will be for office hours with teachers, related services and extra help with instructional paraprofessionals.
